# All exercises are from the Rubank Advanced Method, Volume 1, except Percussion and String Bass (Simandl) Flute

- 1. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 28, #9: top line, no repeats, entire exercise, quarter note = 72
- 2. Technical Exercise: pg. 51, #16; entire exercise, half note = 92

## Oboe

- 1. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 26, #8: top line, no repeats, entire exercise, quarter note = 84
- 2. Technical Exercise: pg. 50-51, #20: no repeat / take 2nd ending, dotted quarter note = 112

#### Bassoon

- 1. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 20, #2: top line, no repeats, entire exercise, quarter note = 90
- 2. Technical Exercise: pg. 27, #13, entire exercise, quarter note =132

#### Clarinet

- 3. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 32, #11: top line, beginning to meas. 15 plus one note, no repeats, eighth note = 108
- 4. Technical Exercise: pg. 52, #12, entire exercise, quarter note = 88

#### Low Clarinets (use clarinet book)

- 1. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 25, #7, bottom line, no repeats, entire exercise, quarter note = 88
- 2. Technical Exercise: pg. 50, #4; entire exercise, quarter note = 128

#### Alto, Tenor and Bari Saxophone

- 1. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 30, #12; beginning measure 31 plus one note, quarter note = 84
- 2. Technical Exercise: pg. 42-43, #25, measures 1-32, no repeats, quarter note =138

#### **Trumpet**

- 1. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 37-38, #21, top line, no repeats, quarter note = 66
- 2. Technical Exercise: pg. 52, #20; entire exercise, quarter note = 130

#### <u>Horn</u>

- 1. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 25, #7, top line, no repeats, entire exercise, quarter note = 80
- 2. Technical Exercise: pg. 23, #3, top line, entire exercise including D.C. al Fine, dotted quarter note = 104

## Trombone, Euphonium BC

- 1. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 45, #25; top line, measure 1-16, dotted quarter note = 72
- 2. Technical Exercise: pg. 40, #22; top line, beginning measure 31 plus one note, quarter note = 120

## **Euphonium TC (use trumpet book)**

- 1. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 43, #25; top line, measure 1-16, No D.C. al Fine, dotted quarter note = 72
- 2. Technical Exercise: pg. 38-39, #22; top line, beginning measure 31 plus one note, quarter note = 120

## Tuba

- 1. Lyrical Exercise: pg. 35, #17; measure 1-13 plus one note, no repeats, quarter note = 76
- 2. Technical Exercise: pg. 70, #3; start of 3<sup>rd</sup> line through the end, no repeat, quarter note = 132
- 30 Etudes for the String Bass F. Simandl Carl Fisher

#### **String Bass**

- 1. Lyrical No.1 play measure 33 to the end, page 3, quarter note = 100
- 2. Technical No. 5 play from the beginning to measure 40 (half note A), page 7, quarter note =120 Additional Information:
  - 1. Scales will be played 1 (one) octave for all instruments. Octave will be played as specified on each instruments scale sheet.
  - Students will have 4 minutes from the first note of the C scale to complete the scale requirements: 12 major scales, C Harmonic Minor, A melodic minor, chromatic scale
  - 3. Students must pass 5 (five) major scales and related arpeggios to continue the audition process.
  - 4. Student will perform a lyrical exercise and a technical exercise for the audition.
  - 5. Student will sight-read as part of the audition.
  - 6. Each student will be required to have the Rubank Advanced Method for their instrument with them at the All State Registration in order to participate in the tryout.
