Solos are yellow, ensembles are green. Only superior ratings get medals. We will take cash, personal or school checks written out to District 5 ABA. Medals can, of course, be purchased after the fact, and mailed to you upon receiving payment.

Percussion equipment that is provided include the following: 1 Bass, 1 Snare, 3 Timpani, 1 Glockenspiel, 1 Xylophone (have students bring their own sticks/mallets)
