### 1. <u>Scales (10 Points Total - 1 point for each Scale, 1 point for each Arpeggio)</u>

Students should perform the following scales and arpeggios as shown on the second and third page of this document. These can also be found through the Jazz Division section on alaband.org. Scales should be played in a SWING STYLE, HANDS TOGETHER in the order listed below. Each scale and arpeggio listed are in CONCERT PITCH.

This book is not instrument specific. Students should use the **C Treble section** of the book. Students should seek out recordings to listen for style as well as comp and improvisation models.

For this section of the audition, students should record themselves playing along with the pre-set backtrack for PIANO is available through the Jazz Division section of alaband.org.

With the backtrack for PIANO, play three times: play the melody one time, comp chords during the second chorus (use the chord symbols to play the written chords), and improvise the third chorus (1<sup>st</sup> time melody, 2<sup>nd</sup> time comp, 3<sup>st</sup> time improvise).



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
